

Bye-Law 8

Student Representatives and Part-time Officers

1. Positions

- 1.1 The Student Representatives and Part-time Officers shall be:
- 1.1.1 The Postgraduate Research Representative (HSS), representing students on postgraduate research courses run by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences.
 - 1.1.2 The Postgraduate Taught Representative (HSS), representing students on postgraduate taught courses run by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences.
 - 1.1.3 The International Representative (HSS), representing international (including EU) students studying courses run by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences.
 - 1.1.4 The Postgraduate Research Representative (S&E), representing students on postgraduate research courses run by the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
 - 1.1.5 The Postgraduate Taught Representative (S&E), representing students on postgraduate taught courses run by the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
 - 1.1.6 The International Representative (S&E), representing international (including EU) students studying courses run by the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
 - 1.1.7 The Postgraduate Research Representative (BL), representing students on postgraduate research courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.8 The Postgraduate Taught Representative (BL), representing students on postgraduate taught courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.9 The International Representative (BL), representing international (including EU) students studying courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.10 One representative from each of the eight schools of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, each representing the students studying courses run by that faculty:
 - 1. School of Business and Management.
 - 2. School of Economics and Finance.
 - 3. School of English and Drama.
 - 4. School of Geography.
 - 5. School of History.
 - 6. School of Languages, Linguistics and Film.
 - 7. School of Law.
 - 8. School of Politics and International Relations.

- 1.1.12 School of Medical and Dental Sciences Pre-Clinical (Medicine) Representative, representing students studying in Part 1, Part 2 of the MBBS program or a foundation level of a medicine-related course in Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry at Queen Mary University of London.
 - 1.1.13 School of Medical and Dental Sciences Clinical (Medicine) Representative, representing students that have entered Part 3 of the MBBS program or are pursuing an intercalated degree of a medicine-related course in Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry at Queen Mary University of London
 - 1.1.14 The School of Medical and Dental Sciences (Dental) Representative, representing students studying BDS Dentistry at Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.15 The Dental Society President, representing students studying BDS Dentistry at Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.16 The Gozo Representative, representing students studying at the Medical School in Gozo, Malta.
 - 1.1.17 The Allied Courses Representative, representing undergraduate allied and non-clinical students at Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.18 The LGBT+ Representative (Mile End), representing students who self-define as LGBT+ and study courses run either by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
 - 1.1.19 The BAME Representative (Mile End), representing students who self-define as BAME and study courses run either by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
 - 1.1.20 The Disabled and Specific Learning Difference Representative (Mile End), representing students who self-define as disabled or having a specific learning difference and study courses run either by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
 - 1.1.21 The Women's Representative (Mile End), representing students who self-define as women and study courses run by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
 - 1.1.22 The LGBT+ Representative (BL), representing students who self-define as LGBT+ and study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.23 The BAME Representative (BL), representing students who self-define as BAME and study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.24 The Disabled and Specific Learning Difference Representative (BL), representing students who self-define as disabled or having a specific learning difference and study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.25 The Women's Representative (BL), representing students who self-define as women and study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
 - 1.1.26 The Trans Representative, representing students who self-define as transgender or as not possessing the gender they were assigned at birth.
 - 1.1.27 The Welfare Officer (HSS), representing students in the Faculty of Humanities and

Social Sciences.

- 1.1.28 The Welfare Officer (S&E), representing students in the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
- 1.1.29 The Welfare Officer (BL), representing students in Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
- 1.1.30 The Sports Officer (Mile End), representing students who study courses run by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or the Faculty of Engineering.
- 1.1.31 The Sports Officer (BL), representing students who study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
- 1.1.32 The Societies Officer (Mile End), representing students who study courses run by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or the Faculty of Engineering.
- 1.1.33 The Societies Officer (BL), representing students who study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
- 1.1.34 The Volunteering Officer (Mile End), representing students who study courses run by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or the Faculty of Engineering.
- 1.1.35 The Volunteering Officer (BL), representing students who study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
- 1.1.36 The Commercial Services Officer, representing all students.
- 1.1.37 The Sustainability Officer, representing all students.
- 1.1.38 The VP Barts, representing students who study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
- 1.1.39 The VP London, representing students who study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.

2. **Non-Council Positions**

- 2.1 The Non-Council Positions shall be:
 - 2.1.1 The RAG Officer (Mile End), elected by students who study courses run by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or the Faculty of Engineering.
 - 2.1.2 The RAG Officer (BL), elected by students who study courses run by Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry.
- 2.2 The Non-Council Positions shall not sit on Student Council.

3. **Eligibility**

- 3.1 All Representatives and Part-time Officers shall be elected by and from the cohort of students which they represent, with one exception: the Trans Representative will be elected by LGBT+ students.
 - 3.1.1 With respect to LGBT+ students, BME students, students with disabilities or specific learning differences and women students, students will be asked to self-define within these groups before voting. This information will not be recorded, and a definition of each liberation group, to be agreed by the relevant group representative, will be provided at the time of self-identification.

- 3.2 All Representatives, Part-time Officers and Non-Council Positions must be student members for their full term of office.

4. Duties and Responsibilities

- 4.0 All Representatives and Part-time Officers shall:
- 4.0.1 Engage with and lobby Queen Mary University of London and other relevant organisations to achieve improvements for the students they represent.
 - 4.0.2 Seek feedback from their cohort in order accurately to represent their interests.
 - 4.0.3 Where appropriate, support the Executive Committee in their duties and responsibilities and seek support from them with respect to their own duties and responsibilities.
 - 4.0.4 Cooperate and coordinate with officers and representatives with the same remit across different campuses, where appropriate.
 - 4.0.5 Liaise with members of student groups relevant to their role.
 - 4.0.6 Carry out all other duties as stated in their role description, which will be determined by Student Council and reviewed from time to time.
- 4.1 The **Postgraduate Research Representative (HSS)** shall:
- 4.1.1 Carry out the duties laid out above in cooperation and coordination with the Postgraduate Research Representative (S&E) and the Postgraduate Research Representative (BL).
 - 4.1.2 Be a member of the Humanities and Social Sciences Board.
- 4.2 The **Postgraduate Taught Representative (HSS)** shall:
- 4.2.1 Carry out the duties laid out above in cooperation and coordination with the Postgraduate Taught Representative (S&E) and the Postgraduate Taught Representative (BL).
 - 4.2.2 Be a member of the Humanities and Social Sciences Board
- 4.3 The **International Representative (HSS)** shall:
- 4.3.1 Carry out the duties laid out above in cooperation and coordination with the International Representative (S&E) and the International Representative (BL).
 - 4.3.2 Be a member of the Humanities and Social Sciences Board
- 4.4 The **Postgraduate Research Representative (S&E)** shall:

 - 4.11.2 Be a member of the Science and Engineering Board.
- 4.12 The **School of Medical and Dental Sciences Pre-Clinical (Medicine) Representative** shall:
 - 4.12.1 Carry out the duties laid out above in cooperation and coordination with the other School of Medical and Dental Sciences representatives and the representatives from the schools from both the Faculties of Humanities and Social Sciences, and Science and Engineering.
 - 4.12.2 Co-chair the MBBS Junior Student-Staff Liaison Committee and be a member of the BLSA Board.

- 4.13 The **School of Medical and Dental Sciences Clinical (Medicine) Representative** shall:
- 4.13.1 Carry out the duties laid out above in cooperation and coordination with the other School of Medical and Dental Sciences representatives and the representatives from the schools from both the Faculties of Humanities and Social Sciences, and Science and Engineering.
 - 4.13.2 Co-chair the MBBS Senior Student-Staff Liaison Committee be a member of BLSA Board.
- 4.14 The **School of Medical and Dental Sciences (Dental) Representative** shall:
- 4.14.1 Carry out the duties laid out above in cooperation and coordination with the other School of Medical and Dental Sciences representatives and the representatives from the schools from both the Faculties of Humanities and Social Sciences, and Science and Engineering.
 - 4.14.2 Be a member of the BLSA Board.
- 4.15 The **Dental Society President** shall:
- 4.15.1 Be responsible for the affairs of the Dental Society according to the provisions of the constitution of the Dental Society.
 - 4.15.2 Be a member of the BLSA Board.
- 4.16 The **Gozo Representative** shall:
- 4.16.1 Carry out the duties laid out above in cooperation and coordination with the Vice President Barts and The London.
 - 4.16.2 Be a member of the BLSA Board.
- 4.17 The **Allied Courses Representative** shall:
- 4.17.1 Carry out the duties laid out above.
 - 4.17.2 Be a member of the BLSA Board.
- 4.18 The **LGBT+ Representative (Mile End)** shall:

- 4.29 The **Welfare Officer (BL)** shall:
 - 4.29.1 Carry out the duties laid out above in cooperation and coordination with the Welfare Representative (S&E) and the Welfare Representative (BL).
 - 4.29.2 Represent all students in Barts and The London School of Medicine and Dentistry and assist the Executive Committee in being these students' voice on welfare, community and liberation-related issues.
 - 4.29.3 Be a member of the Welfare Board and be a member of the BLSA Board.
- 4.30 The **Sports Officer (Mile End)** shall:
 - 4.30.1 Represent the interests of Mile End sports clubs and be the voice of Mile End London sports club members.
 - 4.30.2 Convene and co-ordinate with the Sports Officer (BL) the Club Sport Committee as defined in Bye-Law 22.
 - 4.30.3 Convene and co-ordinate with relevant members of staff regarding events, training, general support and Union communication for Queen Mary sports clubs, as the Mile End Sports Officer deems appropriate.
 - 4.30.4 Ensure that the interests of Queen Mary Sports Clubs are represented during funding allocations, by being involved with the funding allocation process.
 - 4.30.5 Be the student face of Mile End sports clubs and accessible to students with sports club inquiries.
 - 4.30.6 Actively work to develop Mile End sports clubs.
 - 4.30.7 Be a member of the Union Development Board.
 - 4.30.8 Carry out additional duties as outlined in the Bye-Laws.
- 4.31 The **Sports Officer (BL)** shall:
 - 4.31.1 Represent the interests of Barts and The London sports clubs and be the voice of Mile End London sports club members.
 - 4.31.2 Convene and co-ordinate with the Sports Officer (Mile End) the Club Sport Committee as defined in Bye-Law 22.
 - 4.31.3 Convene and co-ordinate with relevant members of staff regarding events, training, general support and Union communication for Barts and The London sports clubs, as the Sports Officer (BL) deems appropriate.
 - 4.31.4 Ensure that the interests of Barts and The London sports clubs are represented during funding allocations, by being involved with the funding allocation process.
 - 4.31.5 Be the student face of Barts and The London sports clubs and accessible to students with sports club inquiries.
 - 4.31.6 Actively work to develop Barts and The London sports clubs.
 - 4.31.7 Carry out additional duties as outlined in the Bye-Laws.
 - 4.31.8 Be a member of the BLSA Board.

4.32 The **Societies Officer (Mile End)** shall:

- 4.32.1 Represent the interests of Mile End societies and be the voice of Mile End society members.
- 4.32.2 Convene and co-ordinate with the Societies Officer (BL) the Union's Societies Board as defined in Bye-Law 22.
- 4.32.3 Assist relevant members of Union staff with events, training and general support for Mile End societies.
- 4.32.4 Encourage and aid Union communication with Mile End societies.
- 4.32.5 Be the student face of Mile End societies and accessible to students with society inquiries.
- 4.32.6 Actively work to develop Mile End societies.

- 4.34.4 With the Volunteering Officer (BL) be the student face of the Union's volunteering service and accessible to students with volunteering inquiries.
- 4.34.5 Actively work to develop the Union's volunteering service.
- 4.34.6 Be a member of the Union Development Board.

- 4.34.7 Carry out additional duties as outlined in the Bye-Laws.
- 4.35 The **Volunteering Officer (BL)** shall:
 - 4.35.1 Represent the interests of the Union's volunteering service and be the voice of its Barts and The London members.
 - 4.35.2 Cooperate and co-ordinate with the Volunteering Officer (Mile End).
 - 4.35.3 Assist relevant members of Union staff with events, training and general support for volunteering groups.
 - 4.35.4 With the Volunteering Officer (Mile End) be the student face of the Union's volunteering service and accessible to students with volunteering inquiries.
 - 4.35.5 Actively work to develop the Union's volunteering service.
 - 4.35.6 Carry out additional duties as outlined in the Bye-Laws.
 - 4.35.7 Be a member of the BLSA Board.
- 4.36 The **Commercial Services Officer** shall:
 - 4.36.1 Represent the interests of the Union's commercial services student staff and be the voice of the members who are using the commercial services of the Union.
 - 4.36.2 Convene and co-ordinate the Students' Union Commercial Services Committee.
 - 4.36.3 Assist relevant members of Union staff with events, training and general support for the development of commercial services on campus.
 - 4.36.4 Actively work to develop the Unions commercial services.
 - 4.36.5 Be a member of the Union Development Board.
 - 4.36.6 Carry out additional duties as outlined in the Bye-Laws.
- 4.37 The **Sustainability Officer** shall:
 - 4.37.1 Engage with and lobby Queen Mary University of London to meet its obligations regarding environmental issues and the global climate emergency.
 - 4.37.2 Engage with relevant external campaigns raising awareness of environmental issues and the global climate emergency, including NUS.
 - 4.37.3 Educate and raise awareness among the student body of environmental issues and the global climate emergency, and the structural and individual ways students can address it.
 - 4.37.4 Be a member of the Union Development Board.
- 4.38 The **Vice President Barts** shall:
 - 4.38.1 Support the Vice President Barts and The London in their duties and responsibilities.
 - 4.38.2 Be responsible for the organisation of Barts and The London graduation events.
 - 4.38.3 Convene and co-ordinate the Barts and The London Graduation Committee.

- 4.38.4 Co-ordinate the Barts and The London Entertainments Officers and the RAG Officer (BL).
- 4.38.5 Be a member of the Union Development Board and be a member of BLSA Board.
- 4.39 The **Vice President London** shall:
 - 4.39.1 Support the Vice President Barts and The London in their duties and responsibilities.
 - 4.39.2 Be responsible for the organisation of Barts and The London graduation events.
 - 4.39.3 Convene and co-ordinate the Barts and The London Graduation Committee.
 - 4.39.4 Co-ordinate the Societies Officer (BL), Sports Officer (BL) and the Volunteering Officer (BL).
 - 4.39.5 Be a member of the Union Development Board and be a member of the BLSA Board
- 4.40 The **RAG Officer (Mile End)** shall:
 - 4.40.1 Convene and co-ordinate the Union's Mile End RAG Committee.
 - 4.40.2 Be responsible for planning and delivery of all Mile End RAG activity including the expenditure of any funds as directed by the Mile End RAG Committee.
 - 4.40.3 Ensure that all Mile End RAG events are organised in collaboration with the Union and adhere to Health and Safety requirements, financial requirements and the Equal Opportunities policy.
 - 4.40.4 Liaise with selected charities, external organisations or causes who money is raised for.
 - 4.40.5 Engage, report and consult with the Societies Board.
 - 4.40.6 Develop charity fundraising within Mile End sports clubs, societies and student groups.
- 4.41 The **RAG Officer (BL)** shall:
 - 4.41.1 Convene and co-ordinate the Union's Barts and The London RAG Committee.
 - 4.41.2 Be responsible for planning and delivery of all Barts and The London RAG activity including the expenditure of any funds as directed by the Barts and The London RAG Committee.
 - 4.41.3 Ensure that all Barts and The London RAG events are organised in collaboration with the Union and adhere to Health and Safety requirements, financial requirements and the Equal Opportunities policy.
 - 4.41.4 Liaise with selected charities, external organisations or causes who money is raised for.
 - 4.41.5 Engage, report and consult with the Societies Board.
 - 4.41.6 Develop charity fundraising within Barts and The London sports clubs, societies and student groups.
 - 4.41.7 Be a member of the BLSA Board.

5. Term of Office

- 5.0 Student Representatives, Part-time Officers and Non-Council Positions shall hold office from 1 August in the year in which they are elected to 31 July in the following year.
- 5.1 No person may hold more than one Student Representative, Officer or Non-Council Position role at any one time.

6. Dismissal / Resignation

- 6.0 A Student Representative, Officer or Non-Council Position postholder shall cease to hold office:
 - 6.0.1 Upon written notice of resignation sent to the Student Council Chair.
 - 6.0.2 Upon the passing of a motion of no-confidence by a simple majority of members of Student Council present and voting at a quorate meeting.
 - 6.0.3 Upon the passing of a resolution by a simple majority of members of Student Council present and voting at a quorate meeting in the event that the person concerned has failed to attend either two consecutive or three in total meetings of the Student Council without providing proper cause to the Student Council Chair or Student Council Clerk.
- 6.1 If a Student Representative, Officer or Non-Council Position postholder ceases to hold office, a by-election will be called in accordance with Elections Bye-Law as soon as reasonably possible.

7. Student Council Chair

- 7.0 There shall be a Student Council chair elected by all members.
- 7.1 The Student Council Chair shall:
 - 7.1.1 Be the Chair for meetings of Student Council, the Annual Members Meeting and Company Law General Meetings.
 - 7.1.2 Ensure all Student Council meetings are held in accordance with the Articles of Association, Bye-Laws and Policy.
 - 7.1.3 Ensure all Student Representatives and Part-time Officers are held to account.
 - 7.1.4 Carry out all other duties as stated in the Articles of Association, Bye-Laws, Policy or delegated from the Board of Trustees or Student Council.
- 7.2 The Student Council Chair shall hold office from 1 August in the year in which they are elected to 31 July in the following year.
- 7.3 The Student Council Chair shall cease to hold office:
 - 7.3.1 Upon written notice of resignation sent to the Student Council Clerk.
 - 7.3.2 Upon the passing of a motion of no-confidence by a simple majority of members of Student Council present and voting at a quorate meeting.
- 7.4 If the Student Council Chair resigns, is deemed to have resigned or if there is a vacant post then there will be an election held at the next meeting of Student Council administered by the Student Council Clerk.

8. Definitions and Interpretation

| 7.1.8 | “medical students” | Members studying a medicine-related course in the Faculty of Barts and The London Queen Mary University of London. |
| 7.1.9 | “Mile End students” | Members studying a course in the Faculty of Humanities and Social Science and the Faculty of Science and Engineering Queen Mary University of London. |
| 7.1.10 | “BAME students” | Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic students; i.e. members who self-define as of African, Asian, Caribbean, Arab, Latin American and Pacific descent. |
