## Have your BLSAy

- Create open specific forums to make the university recognise what matters to us to maintain the student experience with the expansion of year groups.
- Create a 2-step process for fund applications to stop entries being rejected on issues regarding clarity.
- Work with Dentsoc to escalate poor facilities impacting placement and provide specific dental educational models in the BLSA Study Room.
- Improve communication with the students on the Gozo campus, address the lack of resources and improve student support.
- Reinstate placement swap and improve the SCAP procedure.

## Put your Education first

- Ensure adequate UK MLA prep and support.
- Address the library space and resource issues with an interactive floor plan map.
- Host focussed year group discussions alongside the BRAIDE project to ensure a more diverse Graduate 2025 curriculum.

## Celebrate our Community

- Introduce BLINC [Barts and The London Improving Networks and Community] project to strengthen the BLSA Community.
- Run an event to celebrate the contribution of Allied Course students to the BLSA.
- Work with societies to stream academic talks.
- Repeat and further diversify events that celebrate women students.

## Work for your Welfare

- Push for a clear and easy to use reporting system for all students for issues on campus, placement, online or elsewhere.
- Provide more advice and counselling services across our different campuses and push for BME staff presence.
- Support students right to practice their faith by incorporating the protected hour of Friday prayer into timetables and work with students to find adequate space.
- Fight for International Student fees to be frozen and address the threatened placement charge.

## Make QMSU sustainable

- Cut single use plastic consumption in the SU outlets with reusable cups and tupperware schemes.
- Work with the university to fight the lack of recycling by educating the staff and students.
- Introduce food waste bins into halls.
- Encourage student groups to donate food after events or conferences.
