During 2023-24 and 2024-5 the Students' Union conducted a review of its democratic structure and processes. These were approved by the Student Council and the Board of Trustees, and have now been implemented. The final step in the process is to amend the Union's constitution (our Articles of Association) to reflect those changes and register them with the Charity Commission and Companies House. This requires us to hold an Annual General Meeting (AGM) and pass the amendments by a two-thirds majority.

Therefore, the first part of this meeting will be held according to company law. This means that any Member who was unable to attend and vote on these amendments was able to appoint someone to do so on their behalf - this is called appointing a proxy. Proxy votes will be added to the total of votes cast this evening.

The current Articles of Association and the Special Resolution containing the amendments have been published on the Students' Union website.
