Should the Union lobby the University to enable undergraduate International Students studying Law to access Vacation Schemes?

What do you want?

Could the Students' Union make the School of Law grant temporary 'leave of absence' on an ad hoc basis for undergraduate international students to partake in vacation schemes?

Why do you want it?

Undergraduate international students face an extremely harsh disadvantage in terms of their employability prospects because the university term dates clash with several vacation scheme dates. These vacation schemes take up to 40 hours or more per week and international students being limited by the 20-hour work limit during term time are ineligible to apply as a result.

What impact will this have?

International students will be able to take part in vacation schemes and increase their employability prospects.
