Antisemitism Awareness Month - debrief with Jewish and Israel society (JSOC) went well, with still room for improvement. London Renters Union – interviewed them with Jack, and asked more about them and how students can get involved. This was recorded and should be shared for students. Volunteering Board – attended this, discussed the upcoming volunteering week. VP People, Culture and Inclusion – had regular catch up, discussed events and co-presenting an update on a project enabling plan. Asian Heritage Month – had the organising committee. Project Talk – had a few more interviews which went well. DiversIsh – the event took place last night, which went well. Rent – With Jack and Shamima, met with the student campaign to discuss the motion and progress, meeting with the University at the end of today. **Jack Update** Widening Participation - met University staff about the Access and Participation Plan. OFS are encouraging students to submit how Universities are doing on their plan. Jack will start this. Student Council – passed two motions at student council. Sexual and Gender-Based Violence - tested out the practicalities around the consultation, which went well. This will take place next Wednesday. Student Support Meeting – went with Tiana to do this which brings together student support officers across the schools. Spoke about Covid Mitigation and practical issues on the ground. President – had 121 with Shamima and reflected on the last month which was helpful. Elections – hosted the drop-in for students with disabilities and specific learning difficulties. Occupation Health – fed back on the wording when students are being told when being invited to a meeting which the team will review. Mat has feedback on specific issues related to what medics on placement are being advised. EQSB Degree Algorithm – attended this meeting UCL - met with an alumni who wanted to talk about student mental health and a start-up they are working on. Will connect them with someone in the University. Project Talk – had interviews for this and more today. Student Meeting - organising a meeting between the VP PC&I and estranged students as part of the Universities commitment to the stand-alone pledge, and listen to these students experiences first hand. International Fees- have lobbied the University to resolve the issue about the deadline for payment and impact it is having on students. Shamima Update UKES – University survey will be going out soon. 121s - have met with all the Exec, have found them really useful. Rent – been supporting the team with this. Q&A – had this with executive officers across the country about fees, where they had the chance to

speak to organisers of the national campaign, which Shamima is involved with.

Elections Working Group – continuing to be a part of this. Attended the manifesto writing workshop. University Council Report – submitted this regular report to the University for the meeting at the end of the month.

VP Education – met with them, discussed a future-proofing workshop.

Asian heritage month – attended the organising committee for this and enjoyed it.
