	Postgraduate Taught – Wrote to Law PGT Course Reps asking them to encourage Centre for Commercial Law PGT Law students to fill out the Postgraduate Taught Experience Survey. Discussed conducting lecture shout outs in other Schools/Institutes where response rates are low, with QMUL.	
	Postgraduate Research – Attended and contributed to meeting hosted by Deputy Dean for PGRs in Medicine and Dentistry with many PGR reps who are not in the Students' Union's Subject Representative structure. Fed back concern about hosting faculty-specific PGR meetings in addition to those hosted by the Doctoral College for fear of overwhelming representatives with meetings. Started brainstorming and planning events related to the Enhancing Research and Innovation Cultures funding he received.	
1	Sustainability — Discussed with Students' Union staff the suggested amendments/rewrites of existing sustainability policies to get them in line with the union and university's strategies, with the view of submitting the revisions as new policies to the next Student Council. Chased guidelines on submitting media for university screens, in order to promote the Cabinet Cultures project currently on view in the Old Library.
