Attended Action for Sustainability in the Curriculum event with VP HSS and fed back importance of thinking about from whose disciplinary perspective sustainability is taught in the curriculum.	
1	Postgrads – Facilitated first Postgraduate Consultation Group (PGCG) with help of the Postgraduate Research Representation Assistant (PGRRA) on the theme of PGR Communities. PGCG was well attended, and engagement was strong around themes of School/Institute events and PGR spaces. Met with PGRRA and Postgraduate Engagement Assistant to discuss how we might work together this year and discussed plans for disseminating information about our roles through the Doctoral College. Set up meeting with the Dental President and Dental Vice Presidents to discuss PGT engagement and feedback.	
•	International Students – Met with BL International Representative, Aisha, and the International Student Advisors to discuss shared student concerns in absence of higher management meeting to feed issues into. Discussed ways in which the Students' Union might take a more active approach to supporting international students beyond continued work lobbying for fee reductions. Subsequently learned the S&E International Representative is trying to meet with his other faculty counterparts and asked to attend for collective organising.	
	Liberation – Asked the Head of Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI) to meet with him, and the Mile End BAME Representative to discuss how to feed into the Race Equality Action Group and raised ongoing Student Council policies around free menstrual products on campus as well as QM acknowledging its institutional racism more actively. Now setting up subsequent meetings with the Head of EDI and Gender EDI Manager to take these motions forward. Worked with Disability Awareness Fortnight student organising committee members on getting PGR students engaged with an event focusing on disability research at QM.
