1	Bilge Strategy Data Collection – all Exec supported an event in Library square to help collect data on Thursday. PGR Reps – met to discuss recent issues with Subject Rep election and the PG Hub, Saynab and Radhika also attended. DEAG – Updated on the PG Hub and PG communications. Internship Project – looking and doing something similar for the website as done for PG funding e.g. tips, guidance and engagement content. Looking at what events could be run, will be speaking to careers. Faculty Student Experience Staff – they are supporting with some of the University meetings	
2	Radhika Returned from two weeks of sick leave and have been catching up. Ukraine – discussed with Students' Union staff and executive officers, the statement and collating and communicating the support available. Meeting with the University taking place to plan ahead for support. PG – discussing with reps the governance structure, they would like specific PG representation. Alumni Café – event taking place on 30 th March, working on that. International Forum – discussed helping Ukraine, Russian and other affected students. Senior staff will be liaising with national bodies on these issues. Asking what UUK are doing on this. Also discussed having a sustainable plan for international work study visa issues and bursaries and scholarships available. Graduate Attributes – meeting today. Equality Diversity & Inclusion Steering group also taking place today.	
3	Saynab Ethical Investment – a presentation was given about how ethically QM can invest, Students' Union staff and reps are going to be reviewing and looking at an actual policy. Senate – Attended this, went through the Unions report. Ukraine – spent time working on the statement. Societies have fed back positively.
