1	Jack Update Values In Action – met with QMUL staff to discuss workstream Jack is leading on, includes projects such as Humans of QM. Drug & Alcohol Harm Prevention – planning for a campaign to be run later in the year, connecting with SMD. Residences Strategy Group – attended this with exec, formally raised concerns on some of the confidential items on the agenda. Rent – meetings with QMUL and the Rent Strike campaign with Tiana. LGBT+ History Month – sat on a panel for an event around mental health. Welfare Board – took place, not all reps attended, did have productive discussions on areas such as changes to the liberation forums. Mental Health First Aid – attended a support session for these first aiders. Good discussion there on support for students, gave an update of what the Union is doing to support students. Covid Mitigation – attended this with Aphrodite Crime Reduction Partnership – took place, was informative. Graduate Attributes Workstream – enjoyed the discussion there, themes such as employability and soft skills, and the differences between them. Mental Health Day Event – went through the event plan for this, which will take place next week. QMSU/SET – had the monthly with SET and all the exec. Jack and Tiana presented on the People Culture and Inclusion work with the VP People Culture and Inclusion. Raised issues around directing student staff to Student Hardship funds.	Initials

Agreed to take a motion to council to remove Union Development and International Board, as these duplicate conversations at other boards and don't have clear and specific purpose. May replace with less formal forums and focus groups when needed. PG board requires more thought, and will review this and other subcommittees to ensure they are effective and work for students and reps.
