Also set up a meeting between the Malta board and the University of Malta MSA, to begin plans for joint events, raising concerns on joint placements, and even began discussing a Joint Varsity between the two universities. 1 Garrod Move - Last night held a formal workshop between the various faith societies within BL and project management for the Garrod building project, to fully ascertain the requirements for the Multi-Faith Centre, as well as address concerns about overflow space and facilities during Friday prayer and larger events. Barts900 - Last night also attended a meeting with the newly formed Barts900 main committee, where they discussed funding, plans for next year, and how we as a student body aim to interact with other stakeholders (Barts Trust, Barts Heritage, BATLAA, the Medical School, St Barts MCT, etc...)
